# 2024 Wildwinds Members Match Play

## Members:

Welcome to the 2024 Singles and Doubles Match Play. Please sign up below if you are interested in competing. The cost is 10\$ per person for singles and 20\$ per team for doubles. Winner will get 70% of entry fees, Runner-up will get 30%

Play will start Sunday June 17<sup>th</sup>. You will need to arrange your own games.

Space will be limited to 32 Singles and 32 Doubles Teams. This is a single elimination event.

# **Rules:**

1) You must be a member in good standing of Wildwinds Golf Links.

2) You must pay your entry fee by June 10<sup>th</sup>. E-transfer to glopers47@gmail.com, or pay me in person.

3) You must have a Valid Golf Canada Handicap... see below. (I will be checking). If you do not have a valid handicap by start date, you can play from scratch.

4) Handicaps will be played off of the low Handicap person. Use 100% of Handicap. Use Handicap Index.

5) You must complete your match by the posted date, or be disqualified with no refund. You have 3 weeks to complete your match. Contact me if you have an issue....not the Pro Shop. **Get your game in early**....this will avoid defaults

6) All matches will be played from the Blue Tees.

7) Play Summer Rules. If you are in a bunker where the sand has been disturbed, you can rake and place after consulting your opponent.

8) In the event of a tie after 18 holes, play sudden victory starting at the first hole. Handicaps are in play.

9) Going back to the tee when not finding your ball is not allowed. Hit a provisional ball when in doubt. Else forfeit the hole.

## Valid Golf Canada Handicap

- A minimal number of scores is needed to obtain a new handicap. The number of scores needed to establish a Handicap Index is 54 holes from any combination of 18-hole and 9-hole rounds. These must be played in 2024.
- To Maintain a Valid Handicap, you must post your Score after EACH round of golf. You cannot pick and choose which scores you put in.

There are 2 ways you can post your score:

## Post Hole by Hole (Preferred Method)

### Post Adjusted Score:

The Maximum you can post is a double plus your Handicap on a hole.

Example: If your handicap is 18...you can post a maximum of 3 over par on all holes

If your Handicap is 9...you can post a maximum 2 over par on the 9 highest Handicap holes, and 3 over par on the 9 Lowest Handicap holes...1 being the Lowest and 18 being the Highest.

### It is important for the Integrity and fairness of the game to keep a valid handicap
